IBPLC and pattern of study:

Senior students at CHC are working towards achieving the **International Big Picture Learning Credential - (IBPLC)**

The **Graduation Portfolio and IBPLC** can be used to apply for: University, TAFE or Employment.

The Senior pattern of study at CHC includes the following NESA courses:

- English Studies
- Work Studies
- Numeracy
- Visual Design
- Sport, Lifestyle and Recreation
- Computer Applications

Students will receive a Grade for these courses on their RoSA transcript when they leave school.

SBAT's

A school-based apprenticeship or traineeship combines paid work, training and school; as well as an industry recognised national qualification. More info *

Students can apply in Year 10 to begin an SBAT in Year 11.

A host - Employer is needed to support the SBAT which may be established via a successful LTI.

TVET courses

TAFE - delivered Vocational Education and Training courses, TVET course options for 2023 will be available soon. Students attend TAFE one day per week. For more information see the online TVET guide **

Deadline: interested students must complete an EOI form by the **end of Term 2** and complete an interview with our Campus Leader.

NHS subjects

Students have the **option** to study **one** course at Newcastle High that they are passionate about, that links directly to their senior study and portfolio.

This does not make them eligible for a HSC (Higher School Certificate)

If interested, discuss NHS course options with your Advisor.

Deadline: Applications for this option are due to NHS by Week 9, Term 2 . Parents/students receive confirmation in Term 3.
